## The Death of the Shepherd

## Background

October 1147: A group of stragglers from the German crusading army were being escorted back to the main force by Bernard of Plotzkau and a few of his retainers when they were set upon by Moslem horsemen. Bernard was killed in the ensuing melee, the highest ranking Christian noble to die in the Second Crusade.

## Map Layout And Starting Positions



The Christians set up on the map.
The Stragglers begin Wounded.
Moslems enter per special rule (see below) and move first.

## Special Rule

After Christian set up, the Moslem player draws one card unseen from a standard deck to determine which map edge they will enter from. Spades $=$ Side 1 , hearts $=2$, clubs $=3$, diamonds $=4$.

## Victory Conditions

Christian win if there are no more than two Moslems alive and unwounded. Moslems win if they kill eight Christians or six Christians including Balian. If both conditions are met at the same time the Christians win.
