Siege Warfare during the 12th Century Civil War in England and Normandy

THE ANARCHY is the name given to the civil war over the succession to the throne of Henry I Beauclerc, King of England and Duke of Normandy, from 1135 to 1154. This war opposed Stephen of Blois and the Empress Matilda, wife of Geoffrey Plantagenet.

You can play as the followers of the king, the Angevin rebels, and their Welsh and Flemish mercenary allies as they fight to seize castles and abbeys across England and Normandy.



The tactical game includes 3 modular maps and over 100 different characters in various stances: Healthy, stunned, wounded or... dead!



1 map and 2 counter sheets for 5 campaign scenarios in which skirmishes are played out with the tactical game. 15 tactical scenarios of increasing complexity allow for a gradual and easy learning of the rules.

The tactical rules let you simulate any siege technique: Climbing a ladder, using a ram or a siege tower, oil pouring, mining, wall battering and more.

Note: THE ANARCHY is an extension to GUISCARD and DIEX AÏE and needs the rules of one of these two games (available as a free download) to be played.
